This funding will be used to

- Ensure that every student will either achieve the National minimum Standard for literacy and numeracy for their year level or have an evidence-based plan, developed by the school, in place to address their specific learning difficulties
- Improve teacher capability through focused literacy coaching and professional development to improve student performance
- Conduct learning workshops for parents of pre-Prep aged, Prep and Year 1 students in reading and number
- Increase the % of Year 3 students in the U2B in reading from 8% to 15% and in spelling from 9% to 15% within two years
- Increase the % of Prep students achieving Reading PM Level 9 from 4% to 15% within two years

Our strategy will be to

- Analyse student performance data to develop and implement intensive literacy intervention and re-asses students to monitor improvement
- Increase teacher capability through a coaching model and embed a balanced and consistent reading programme with a shared understanding and pedagogical practice of the 5 reading procedures ie: 1. Reading Aloud to Students; 2. Modeled reading; 3. Shared Reading; 4. Guided Reading; 5. Independent Reading across the school
- Purchasing of Teacher Aide time to assist in the reading support programme
- Engage the parents of early learners including local day care centres with best practice strategies and skills for early literacy and numeracy learning

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Purchase Extension Support to STLAN for Early Years Literacy Support (\$75000)
- Purchase Teacher Aide time to provide extensive literacy support for individuals or small groups of students in Prep to Year 3 (\$12,500)
- Provide enhanced resources to support the teaching of literacy across all year levels (\$4500)
- Implementing an outreach programme for parents of pre-Prep, Prep and Year 1 students to provide best practice strategies across literacy and numeracy (\$2020)
